This week we...

- P1- phonics- qu- we have practised finding words with this sound, making words and writing words with the sound.
- P2- y- making the ee sound- again we have practised finding words in books with the 'y' sound, making words and writing them.
- Reading- the class enjoyed listening to other people read, taking turns to read with a different partner or adult. The Primary 1s are working on copying a sentence from their reading book, focusing on finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.
- P2- looked at uplevelling a page of their reading book, adding in adjectives or more detail to make the writing more interesting.
- Writing- we have been learning the actions to our 'Ski Trip Recount'- going over what we did on the ski trip and making sure we had the events in the correct order. This week we begun to write a short recount about the beginning of the trip. Some children ordered the pictures, some drew their own pictures, some added key words and some wrote a full description of the day.
- This week the class thoroughly enjoyed getting out to the woods with the nursery- there was lots of excellent team work going on, fantastic problem solving and risk assessing.
- A huge highlight this week was learning more about science. The class loved making and of course tasting Egyptian bread that they made. They also enjoyed finding out how to mummify an apple. They are looking forward to investigating this further next week by seeing what happened to the apple with nothing on it and what happened to the apply with the 'natron'.
- In numeracy- the P2s have enjoyed finishing off their battleships games whilst the Primary 1s have focused on their number recognition, forwards and backwards number sequence and counting.
- The whole class enjoyed the P7s visiting to teach them how to log onto their Chromebooks and play a painting game- the link is on the classroom so can be played at home.
