This week we...

AOCB

- Primary 1 sounds- word building, looking at words that rhyme- focusing on changing the initial sound in words to create new words. We also focused on reading and writing our common tricky words- we enjoyed using the chalks outside to do this.
- Primary 2- ie- to make the 'ee' sound- field, brownie, cookie, shield. We played lots of games to practise these words.
- Reading- the class enjoyed Eilidh and Ella reading their Egyptian Adventure story to the class and they loved that they were able to discuss it well as they knew lots about it from our topic. It prompted a look on google Earth to view the Sphinx.
- Writing- this week the class continued to learn about recount writing- focusing on order. This week they created actions to 'Our Egyptian Bread Making', being careful to have the steps in the correct order. With a partner they then created a story map and added in extra detail. As a class we then created our best version using lots of ideas from everyone in the class.
- Numeracy – P2- have been working on right angles, finding them in a class and outside. They have directed each other to items using the directional language of 90 right/left turns, 180 degree turns and 360 turns.
- P1 have done a fantastic job of learning about odd and even numbers, creating their own mazes to show their understanding.
- HWB- this week we have talked a lot about kindness, as we near the end of term, sometimes patience has gone and we just need to remember to use kind words and kind actions. We are also focusing on tidying up after ourselves and taking responsibility for our actions.
- The class enjoyed learning about the results of our science experiment- some groups found their results were what they expected and others didn't. The class learnt that the experiment conditions could be altered next time and that it could be carried out again to re-evaluate.
