- This week the class enjoyed a P.E lesson with Mrs Chisholm on Monday as the upper school were skiing. The class enjoyed working on their throwing and catching skills and learning the game bench ball. The class have also enjoyed P.E with Primary 6 as the leaders.

The authors then went to work to write it down on paper. The illustrators have been busy selecting key parts of the story that they wish to illustrate. The front cover team came up with the name of the book and have begun designs for what it should look like. We can't wait to finish this next week and share our story with you. The class also enjoyed listening to different pieces of music related to stories and we discussed how music can help us tell as story too.
- In numeracy this week we have worked on directions- in front of, behind, above, below, right, left, forwards, backwards- we have used the Bee Bots to help us work on this, programming them to go in certain directions and seeing if they make it to the desired destination.
