We did an excellent job of getting the steps in the correct order and using different sentence openers. Some of us did a great job of adding in more detail to the steps we came up with together.
- consolidated what we learnt in numeracy this term. In groups we came up with a game to teach someone about an area we have learnt over the last term. This ranged from games about odd/even numbers to teaching someone how to play battleships and understand grid references.
- thoroughly enjoyed going out to the woods with nursery-thai is great for our problem solving and cooperation skills. This week Mrs Clark brought some Spring baskets that we could use to collect Spring items. Some of us collected dinosaur eggs; some built bird's nest; some played hide and seek.
